

NORTH SAANICH FIRE DEPARTMENT

COVERAGE PROVIDED ON NON-MUNICIPAL LANDS WITHIN DISTRICT

August 2004

- do not do shipboard fires, provide backup, exposure coverage only
- respond to mutual aid calls
- responsible for aircraft outside of airport property
- have limited on water fire or rescue capabilities relying on available borrowed watercraft at the scene or Coast Guard assistance

FEDERAL LANDS WITHIN DISTRICT

INDIAN RESERVES (2)

- under contract at a per residence fee provide **suppression coverage only**
- we have no control over building or fire codes or local bylaws such as burning

PARKS (1)

- responsible for fire suppression only as mutual aid until relieved by Federal personnel

VICTORIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

- prime responsibility for suppression for all buildings on airport property
- assist airport fire department in crash control coverage from 6 am - midnight
- respond to all airport activities after hours
- do fire inspection of airport buildings as per written agreement

INSTITUTE OF OCEAN SCIENCES

- responsible for all fire activities except shipboard fires
- will provide dockside assistance for shipboard fires but will not go below decks
- monitor buildings on fire panel located at Wain Rd. - sets off alarm when activated

AGRICULTURE CANADA- CENTRE FOR PLANT RESEARCH

- responsible for all fire related activities

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

BC FERRY TERMINAL SWARTZ BAY

- responsible for all fire related activities except shipboard fires
- will provide backup and give dockside assistance as per written agreement

DUNSMUIR LODGE

- owned by the University of Victoria
- responsible for all fire related activities

PARKS (2)

- responsible for fire suppression only as mutual aid until relieved by provincial personnel

CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT

PANORAMA LEISURE CENTRE

- responsible for all fire related activities

PARKS (2)

- responsible for fire suppression only until relieved by parks personnel
