Alternative Recycling Depots

DL's Recycling (250-544-3103) - Yard and garden compostables including brush, land clearing (dirty brush), stumps, sod, dirt & rocks. Recycling including cardboard, newspaper, mixed waste paper and metal. Also, chargeable items including drywall, pallets, garbage wood, concrete/bricks, fridges & freezers.

Metal Recycle Depot (250-665-7282) - Recycling includes any type of metal, automotive parts, fluids (oils etc.), & tires. Eco Fees do apply to fridges, freezers, propane tanks & tires. Will also pay for junk vehicles and pick them up for free.

Return It (250-655-4878) - Electronics, including televisions, computer towers, monitors and computer peripherals. Paint products and paint aerosols (see website re: specifics www.islandreturnit.com) Also bottles, cans & plastic recyclables.
