PETITIONS AND DELEGATIONS**BC Ferries Service Agreement**

Aaron Hahn, Project Manager, BC Ferries, noted that detailed design is expected to be completed within the next two months. Force main work along Highway 17 will be the first construction to take place, followed by work on BC Ferries property at Swartz Bay Terminal. The project is expected to take approximately 8 months to complete. Councillor Green noted the ongoing safety concerns along Swartz Bay Road, and Mr. Hahn advised that BC Ferries will look at options that they may be able to accommodate to improve safety with vehicles travelling on Highway 17 and Swartz Bay Road. Councillor Chandler noted that the formula used to calculate the cost for BC Ferries to connect to the North Saanich sewer system is not fair or justified in comparison to other jurisdictions and users and their associated charges. The Director of Infrastructure Services noted the differences in systems for the different jurisdictions and users and why the charges differ for each one. Mayor Finall noted that BC Ferries construction schedule will most likely coincide with the construction of the McTavish Interchange, and asked that BC Ferries staff coordinate their work closely with the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure in order to minimize traffic disruptions and delays.
