WHEREAS It is instrumental to educate and inform all our citizens of our community of the important part they play in making it accessible to all, and

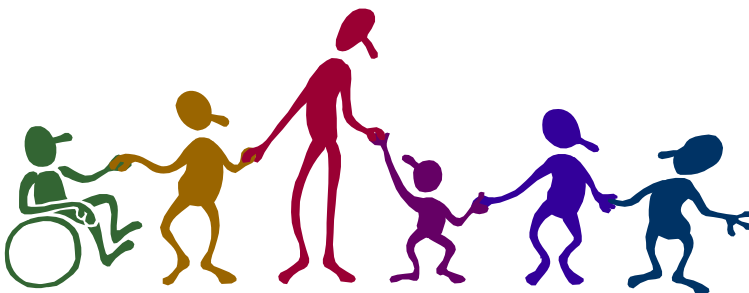
