### APRIL 6, 2010

### "TARTAN DAY"

WHEREAS in February, 1987 at an Antigonish meeting in Nova Scotia the Federation of Scottish Clans in Nova Scotia designated April 6, as Tartan Day in that Province, and

WHEREAS April 6, has historical significance for all Scots, as it is the anniversary date of the signing of the Declaration of Arbroath monastery in the year 1320 in support of Robert the Bruce, and

WHEREAS documented history in this Province details the contributions of the Scottish people to the growth and development of British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the Scottish people have made contributions in a number of areas, including exploration, settlement, government and social progress in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to direct by Order in Council in that behalf that a Proclamation be issued designating April 6 in perpetuity, as "Tartan Day" in British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 6, in perpetuity, shall be known as

"TARTAN DAY"

In British Columbia.

NOW THEREFORE I, Alice Finall, Mayor of the District of North Saanich, do hereby proclaim April 6, 2010 as "TARTAN DAY" in the District of North Saanich.
