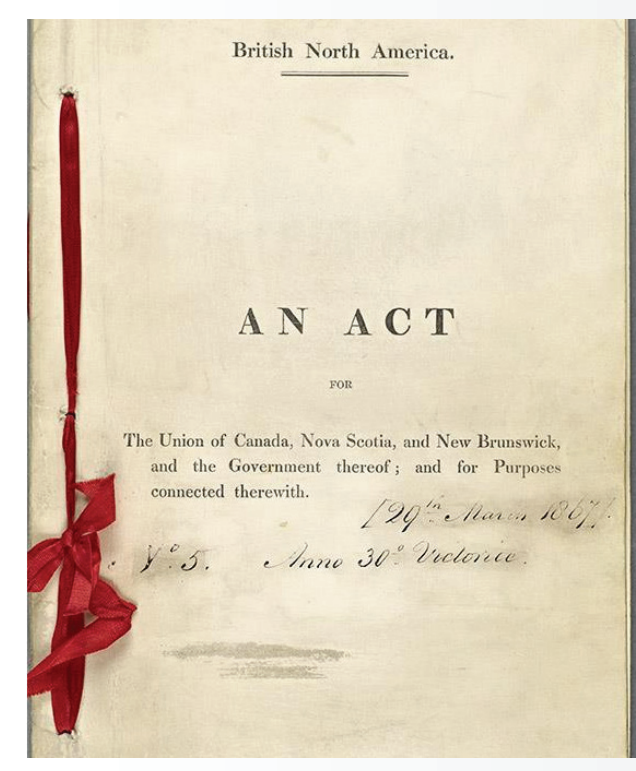
Hudson's Bay Company Acquires Land by Treaty from the WSÁNEĆ (Douglas Treaties)

April 26 - First Black Californians Arrive on Vancouver Island

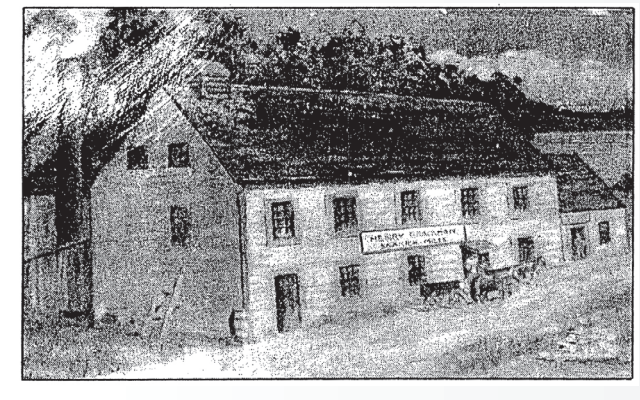
British North American Act passed, whereby the federal government becomes responsible for Indigenous peoples

Holy Trinity Church was consecrated



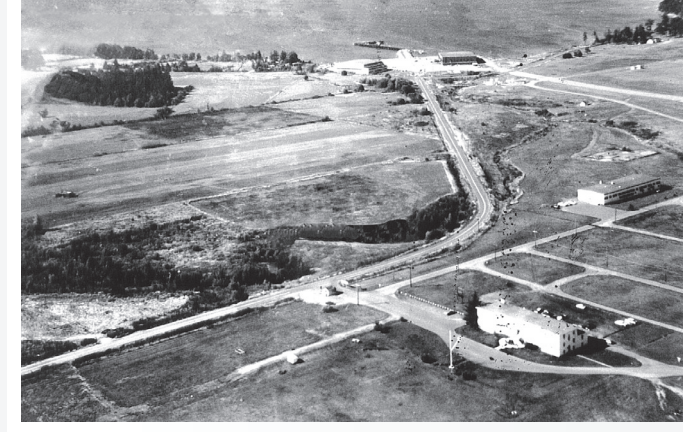
Corporation of the District of North Saanich was incorporated

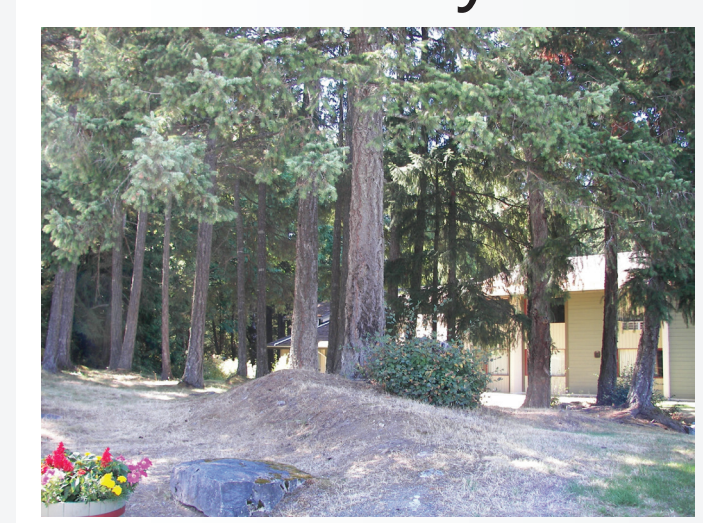
